Oak (T20) should be monitored for signs of decline before pollarding is considered, the recent tarmac works have covered the root plate and the tarmac should be removed for the wellbeing of the tree. Oak (T30) should be refused as the limb removal would be detrimental to the tree and its appearance. The tree was there long before the building was erected and this should have been considered when erecting the building. Oak (T58) seems to be retrospective as there has been a sizeable limb cleanly removed which would have been in the direction of the garden, it would have most likely been quite overbearing, there is some minor branches at the base of the tree around 50mm diameter that are low over the garden, these could be removed, no further limbs should be removed. Oak (T62) this tree has decay at the base as well as a lot of damage to the stems above; this tree should be felled rather than pollarded and a replacement planted nearby.
